

Mahidol University Faculty of Dentistry Announcement on Admissions Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program) Academic Year 2017

Mahidol International Dental School (MIDS) is now open for the submission of applications to the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program) for the Academic year 2017. Mahidol International Dental School hereby announces details on admissions for the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program) for the Academic year 2017.

Admission requirements:

1. General eligibility requirements

To be eligible to apply for the program, the applicant must:

1.1 Be at least 16 years of age upon submission of the application.

1.2 Have no medical condition or disability which may interfere during the educational process and performance as a dentist such as:

- Physical deformities
- Problems with mental health and personality
- Alcoholism or addiction to narcotics or any substance abuse
- Non-communicable diseases without any preventive or controlled treatment such as epilepsy, heart disease, high-blood pressure, nephropathy or diabetes
- Other illnesses or disabilities determined by the Physician Committee for the Admissions, to the Mahidol University, which may not have been previously diagnosed or identified

1.3 Have earned a Mathayom 6 Secondary Education Diploma approved by the Ministry of Education of Thailand. Applicants who graduated from an international school in Thailand or abroad must have finished Grade 12 (American Curriculum) or Year 13 (UK, Wales and New Zealand Curriculum).

PLEASE NOTE:1. Applicants who are currently in their final year and expect to
complete their secondary education before August 2017 must
submit a school enrollment certification letter. The letter must be
issued by the school where he/she is currently enrolled.

2. Applicants must have taken Chemistry, Biology, Physics and Math courses in high school in any kind of curriculum. The grades of these subjects must be shown in their Transcript of Records either in Grade 10, 11 or 12 or in Year 10, 11, 12 or 13

3. IGCSE grades are accepted provided that the applicant is a graduate or is a graduating student of Grade 12 or Year 13 before the Academic Year 2017 begins.

4. GED or General Equivalency Diploma will not be given consideration and will not be accepted in the Doctor of Dental Surgery Program (International Program).

1.4 Not be on expulsion from any institute of higher education due to inappropriate behavior or offense.

2. Interview eligibility requirements

All applicants must **fulfill all the following three requirements** (2.1-2.3) to be eligible for an interview:

2.1 Minimum score of English proficiency exam.

The applicant must have taken his/her English proficiency exam, either TOEFL or IELTS, with two years validity up until the application deadline.

The minimum acceptance scores are:

1. TOEFL

•	Paper-based	540

- Computer-based 207
- Internet-based 76
- 2. IELTS Academic6.0

2.2 Good academic standing.

The applicant must have achieved one of the following:

- Cumulative GPA grade of "2.75" or higher; or
- Cumulative GPA grade of "4" or higher for the IB Diploma Curriculum; or
- Cumulative GPA grade of "B" or higher for the A-Level Curriculum

2.3 Minimum SAT II test scores of 550 per subject.

SAT II subject tests are required for the 3 subjects, namely:

- Biology Molecular (Biology M)
- Chemistry
- either Physics or Math II

The MIDS College and Scholarship Code is <u>7967</u>. Please make a request to the SAT College Board website to send their SAT II subject test scores directly to Mahidol International Dental School (MIDS).

2.4 Take manual skill test which arranged by MIDS

3. Application process

3.1 Applicant must access:

<u>http://www.dt.mahidol.ac.th/MIDS</u> and fill out the online applications form. After filling out the form, the applicant must print out the form and place his/her signature at the bottom of the application form.

3.2 Applicant must submit the following hardcopy documents, either original or photocopy, to the MIDS office **no later than** the application period deadline. All the photocopied documents need to be verified and signed by the applicant before submitting.

- Printed and signed application form from the MIDS's website.
- Certified copy of the most recent transcript (at least four semesters included) showing the applicant's grades in four major subjects during the high school years, namely, Math, Physics, Biology and Chemistry.
 - **PLEASE NOTE:** Applicants will be required to submit their full transcript during the official MIDS enrollment. In case that the full transcript has not been issued, a letter from their current or last school attended must be submitted as the evidence of completion of high school education.
- Official TOEFL or IELTS score (item 2.1)
- Official SAT II scores in the three subjects which should be sent directly from the SAT College Board to MIDS (item 2.3):
 - Biology Molecular (Biology M)
 - Chemistry
 - either Physics or Math II
- A photocopy of identification card or passport
- A photocopy of house registration (Thai residents only)
- A photocopy of a change of name/last name certificate. (only if different from name/last name in the documents required for application.)
- Bank deposit slip of the application fee

The application fee of 3,500 baht is non-refundable. MIDS does not cover the fees that may be charged by the bank or any currency conversion differences. Please deposit the full amount of 3,500 baht to the following account:

PLEASE NOTE: All mailed documents must reach the MIDS office within the application deadline (see item 8: Admissions Schedule). Any application document postmarked before or on December 23th, 2016 but was not received by MIDS office on or before 4:00 p.m. of December 23th, 2016 **WILL NOT** be considered.

4. Selection criteria

The final decision for the admission to MIDS will be based on the SAT II score, interview score and manual skill test score.

• Before entering the interview room, all candidates will be asked to present their proof of identification (original ID card or passport). If any item(s) of the required documents is/are missing, the candidate <u>WILL NOT</u> be allowed for an interview.

• The interview evaluation factors would include, but are not limited to, personality, appearance and manner, self-confidence, ability to communicate, initiative and intelligence, dental professional knowledge, extracurricular activities, enthusiasm, punctuality, general attitude and leadership skills.

5. Number of candidates to be admitted to the program: up to 25

6. Venues of Study

- 6.2 Phayathai Campus for the second to sixth year students
